Subject: Dave Augustine's Database of Useful Information

I was asking Dave about Main Injector site risers and he told be about the database where he stores useful information on AD systems. He was also nice enough to show me how to access it.

Here are the directions:

Open File Maker Pro version 8

Click on REMOTE in Dialog Box

Select (beams-fmpro-2)

From list of options that appear on right side of the screen select ACCELERATOR COMPONENTS

Click OPEN

Log on as GUEST ACCOUNT

Click on the SYSTEM WIDE button

Select the type of device you are interested in - Site Risers, Water Skids, Motor Drives, etc.

In the case of site risers you may notice that Dave refers to items called bombs. Dave's bombs are lengths of PVC pipe of the appropriate diameter for the site riser. The pipe has a cap sealed on one end and then the pipe is filled with poly beads. A cap fitted with an eye bolt is then sealed on the other end of the pipe. The bomb is then lowered into the site riser with a length of steel cable.
